

We are having a peer judged show this year. Meaning it is judged by your peer's not professional judges. The judges will be a combination of members of our guild and quilters from outside our guild all with varying experience but knowledge of quilting. They will not be listed in the program.

Each category will be judged by the same 3 judges on a numeric system. The numeric system will be a list of criteria which is each given a numeric value. Each sheet will be added up and averaged; the top 3 in each category will get ribbons.
