

Kitsap Guild Mystery Quilt 2018

Step 1: choosing fabric.

The directions are for a three-color quilt

Color A: Light: Background. 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards.

Color B: Dark: 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards

Color C: Medium $\frac{3}{4}$ yard

Binding: $\frac{1}{2}$ yard. Color B, or C.

*If you are doing a traditional 2-color quilt, color B and C are the same fabric. This yardage is 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards. (A + B+ binding)

* If you are using multiple shades of one color: separate and label your mediums (Color C) from your darks (Color B)

*If you want a dramatic look by making the background dark (Color A), switch Color B to light, keeping Color C as medium. Binding would be color A.

*Your strips are cut 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " ; 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " ; and 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " , so I suggest you use solids or very small prints.

Early bird directions. Get cutting

Unit 1: You will need;

4 strips of Color A, cut 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF.

4 strips of Color B, cut 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF

Sew each Color A strip to a Color B strip. = **4 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' strata, WOF**

Unit 2. You will need:

8 strips of Color A, cut 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF

8 strips of Color C, cut 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF

Sew each Color A strip to a Color C strip... = **8 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strata, WOF**
